



**Old Wives Watershed Association and Saskatchewan Association of Watersheds
“Wetlands & Wildlife” Poster Contest**



Thank you for expressing interest in Saskatchewan Association of Watershed Annual Poster Contest! The Old Wives Watershed Association is one of 11 provincial watershed stewardship associations participating in this year's contest. The Old Wives Watershed Association (OWWA) will be providing prizes for the top 3 local winners selected from entrants that live within our watershed. The 1st place winner's poster within the Old Wives Watershed will then be judged at the provincial level against the top posters from the other 10 watersheds for the chance to win the provincial prize - which consists of **\$500 prize package for the student and \$500 for their classroom!**

Prizes will be awarded as follows, with no substitutions:

Grand Prize (Provincially): \$500 prize package for the student and \$500 for the student's classroom

Locally: **First Place- \$75.00 cash prize and OWWA merchandise**
 Second Prize- \$50.00 cash prize and OWWA merchandise
 Third Prize- \$25.00 cash prize and OWWA merchandise

Possible ideas for posters:

- **Species at Risk**
- **Importance of Wetlands**
- **How Wildlife interacts with Wetlands**

Contest Details:

1. Contest is open to youth in grades 5, 6, and 7 that attend school within the Old Wives Watershed. All entries should reflect a Wetlands & Wildlife theme.
2. Formatting guidelines:
 - a. Artwork must be 100% hand-drawn, original artwork on 8 ½" x 11" white piece of paper.
 - b. Any medium may be used (pencil crayon, paint, wax crayon, marker etc.)
3. Posters will be judged based on the following criteria:
 - a. Accuracy and knowledge of information presented within the poster (i.e. illustrations demonstrate the student's understanding of the topic).
 - b. The artwork demonstrates an appreciation of water conservation.
 - c. General artistic ability and creativity.
4. All posters are to be mailed or hand delivered to:

5. All entries must be received before 4pm on **Tuesday, December 31st, 2019**, the closing date of the contest.
6. All entries become property of the Old Wives Watershed Association, and may be used in print or promotional materials, social media, newsletters, website, etc. now or in the future.
7. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners of the local contest agree to have their name and poster published in the OWWA newsletters, oldwiveswatershed.com, Facebook, and Twitter.
8. Parent Permission is required on all entries, and this Poster Contest Detail sheet must be completed and attached to each entry. Only one entry per child.
9. Judges at the local level will be OWWA staff and board members. The decision of the judges is final. All winners will be notified by telephone by January 14th, 2020.
10. Provincial judging will occur in at the Saskatchewan Association of Watersheds Annual Conference.
